Application requirements:

<u>Applicant</u>. Applicants must be a graduating high school senior who is in pursuit of furthering their education by attending a community college, four-year college or technical school.

<u>Application</u>. Applicants must submit a completed application form.

Essay. Applicants must submit a three page essay with a minimum of two (2) citations. The essay topic for 2023 is: "HOW CAN SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS ASSIST STUDENTS ADDRESS AND DEAL WITH MENTAL HEALTH ISSUES?"

<u>High School Transcript</u>. Applicants must submit a sealed copy of their high school transcript with the application packet.

<u>Letters of Recommendations</u>. Applicants must submit three (3) original letters of recommendation. Recommendations must be from community and/or school leaders, <u>NOT</u> family members.

Scholastic Aptitude Test Scores. Applicants must submit a copy of their ACT or SAT scores.

<u>School Acceptance Verification</u>. Applicants must submit a copy of the acceptance letter from the academic institution they plan to attend.
